The Club along with other water users and businesses are actively engaged with the Broads Authority over the future of Hickling Broad. The Broad desperately needs to be dredged to enable boats to enter the Pub Staithe and the boat yard safely. We hope to receive an outline timetable of this soon. We will keep you updated with any impact to sailing as soon as we have any news.

Getting to know our Hickling neighbours.

The Club committee led by Martin the Club chairman are working behind the scenes to build closer relationships with our 'neighbours' at Hickling this year. Everyone we have met so far have been very friendly and love the Broad just as much as we do. Many are also involved with the Broad development as mentioned in the above news article. We are looking for ways to help each other, and encourage more locals to join the Club.

Keeping those floors clean ..

We invested £1,500 last year to replace the wooden floor with a floor that was non-slip, could be cleaned and was therefore healthier. The downside is that it does need cleaning. This is currently being done by volunteer labour, usually one of the committee, a task that can take 2 hours just to clean one changing room. To have the floors regularly cleaned would add about £10 to everyone's annual membership fee. We want to avoid this cost to you if we can, so we need your cooperation.

You can therefore reduce the burden by removing muddy boots <u>before</u> walking them over a clean floor. Boots need to come off anyway, so please do this before entering the changing room. Can we also ask the person who leaves sand in the men's shower to please stop it. We can only imagine they are removing sandy/muddy boots in the shower, very unpleasant for others. Boots off outside/at the door or please stop using the changing rooms. (Rant over)
