The charity formed by windsurfers raised some £25,000 last year, contributing to cancer research, education and support. The trustees objective is to try and double that amount this year.

Sunrise to Sunset is again taking place at numerous sites around the country and we are hosting one of the events here at Hickling Broad. Well known windsurfers such as Nick Dempsey, Ross Williams and Dave White are acting as ambassadors to help promote the event to all windsurfing enthusiasts.
