Please note the new condition No.9 of the club's **Code of Practice**.

An imaginary no go area, roughly the size of a football penalty box, would be sufficient enough to help provide safer access to the water for beginners as well as incoming windsurfers during the busier summer months.

# **CODE OF PRACTICE**

The beach is for launching and retrieval of windsurfing boards only.

- 1. No vehicular access to the beach.
- 2. No overnight camping or parking on the car park or beach.
- 3. No barbecues or fires on the beach.
- 4. All padlocks to be kept locked at all times other than for access.
- 5. Members cars to display club sticker.
- 6. No swimming from the beach.
- 7. No dogs.
- 8. No mooring on the beach.
- 9. No freestyle within the vicinity of the launch area.
